Teacher Licensure First Destination Summary

This report is intended to be supplemental to the 2017-2018 CSU First Destination Report to focus specifically on those students who graduated with a degree from CSU and were recommended for teacher licensure by the Center for Educator Preparation. Students who did not receive a degree from CSU in the academic year but did receive a recommendation for teacher licensure are not included in the report including the knowledge rate calculation.

The overall results for teacher licensure candidates have less than a 65% knowledge rate, which is the industry standard for minimum knowledge rate. The data are still included in this report for reference; however, caution should be exercised in drawing conclusions from it. Additionally, all teacher licensure candidates are required to student teach and that should fall into the "Internship Rate" category; however not all students identified as completing an internship so some of those rates are lower than they should be.

Endorsement areas are grouped in this report to provide an opportunity for meaningful numbers. Business, speech and technology education are grouped together, all foreign languages are grouped together, and all of the science endorsement areas are grouped together.

Methodology

All graduating students are encouraged to respond to the First Destination Survey as part of the Graduation Ready process. The current administration of the survey includes graduates from August 2017 through May 2018. Following best practices set by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE), follow-up data were gathered through multiple sources including the CSU Follow-Up Graduation Survey, the National Student Clearinghouse, and LinkedIn. The overall knowledge rate (the percentage of graduates that CSU has knowledge of their post-graduation plans) was 81% (n=4012) for undergraduate students and 70% (n=1536) for graduate students.
